

**RESOLUTION OF THE MKANZINI JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL
INFRASTRUCTURE CRISIS COMMITTEE**

At a meeting held on 23 November 2011 the members of the Mkanzini Junior Secondary School Infrastructure Crisis Committee (the Mkanzini Committee) resolved to instruct the Legal Resources Centre Grahamstown Office to institute legal action against the relevant departments and office bearers of the National and Provincial Governments of the Republic of South Africa.

The legal action arises out of the failure of the Department of Education to provide emergency infrastructure to Mkanzini Junior Secondary School (Mkanzini JSS) to enable it to function and fulfill its mandate.

The purpose of the legal action is to obtain a Court Order to declare that the failure of the Provincial Department of Education and the Minister of Basic Education to provide appropriate emergency facilities for Mkanzini JSS while the school waits for permanent classrooms to be built, or a plan in this regard, is unconstitutional and unlawful and to direct them, and other possible respondents, to provide Mkanzini JSS with appropriate facilities.

The meeting further resolved that Chairperson Fikile Billi, is authorized to sign all necessary legal documents to institute this legal action in furtherance thereof.
