1.1 I am a major male, Director of Legal Services of the Northern Cape Department of Basic Education.

1.2 My office is situated at 156 Barklay Road, Kimberley.

1.3 The facts deposed to herein fall within my person knowledge, save where otherwise stated, and are true and correct.

1 This is a further Affidavit, reporting back to the above Honourable Court in terms of paragraph 103.12 of the Order dated 17 July 2020.

2 I also refer to the previous affidavits filed by the Northern Cape Department of Education.

3 A total number of 281,294 (two hundred and eighty-one thousand two hundred and ninety-four) learners qualify for the NSNP in the province.

4 As at 11 September 2020, the date of the current statistics, 59,743 (fifty-nine thousand seven hundred and forty-three) learners receive meals at schools.



- 5 The balance of the learners, who did not attend school all received food parcels.
- 6 The Provincial Department has made it possible that school meals are assessable to all the learners qualifying for the NSNP, this is done through the distribution of flyers, announcements on local radio stations, and schools reminding learners through all available communication channels.
- 7 Learners use the usual learner transport, transporting learners to school and back, for learners to access cooked meals or food parcels.
