1.1 I am a major male, Head of the Department of the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Education.

1.2 My office is situated at 247 Burger Street, Anton Lembebe Building, Pietermaritzburg.

1.3 The facts deposed to herein fall within my person knowledge, save where otherwise stated, and are true and correct.

2 This is the fourth Affidavit, reporting back to the above Honourable Court in terms of paragraph 103.12 of the Order dated 17 July 2020.

3 In KwaZulu-Natal 1,901,226 (one million nine hundred and one thousand two hundred and twenty-six) learners are receiving meals and the province is consistently improving in the serving of meals to learners at schools. This number reported is based on school attendance and ranged in the 12 districts from a lowest reporting of 10% and 100% in some of the other districts

4 In 7 districts, learners were fed through food parcels or a combination of feeding options. In the other five districts meals were prepared for learners at school.

5 Learner transport continues to be provided for learners attending schools. The Department has ensured that all learners access food. Parents are playing a pivotal role in ensuring that all learners access food by collecting a cooked meal or a food parcel on behalf of learners who are not yet attending schools for various reasons.
